



In the second half of 2016, the State Security Division of the Hellenic Police Headquarters collaborated with the Center of Security Studies on the project "Actions against Radicalization and Extremism" as part of **ISF-funded initiatives**.

The project's implementation took place between May 2016 and October 15 of that same year, during which time:

- 10 certified trainers were trained.
- 3 workshops were held (Athens). One for police officers only, one with participation from public sector organizations and one with participation from "Civil Society" groups.
- 2 interagency trainings were carried out (Athens - Thessaloniki), establishing a network of fifty trainers.
- 5 weekly training programs took place (Athens, Thessaloniki, Alexandroupoli, Mytilini and Chania), with information days for 125 practitioners, open to the public on the last day.
- 1 educational manual was drafted with the goal of incorporating its content into the training curricula of the Correctional Officers', Coast Guard's, and Police Academies.
- 2 pocket guides were published, one for first-line police officers (employees in security services) and the other for stakeholders including teachers and nurses.
- 1 project website was developed.
- 1 DVD with instructional audio-visual content was produced.

At the end of this project, a closing conference was held in Athens, where the effective, where the results of the action were evaluated, in front of representatives of the Hellenic Police leadership, the academic community, and other involved stakeholders.
