



By the Hellenic Police Intelligence Directorate of the Hellenic Police Headquarters has been completed the implementation of the Internal Security Fund (ISF) / Police Cooperation Sector 2014-2020 action entitled "Establishment and function of the Operations Centre – Procurement of specialized software interconnecting databases and information analysis referring to organized crime and terrorism." on behalf of the Hellenic Police, with a 802.821,90 euro budget.

The aforementioned action was co-financed 75% from the European Internal Security Fund / Police Cooperation Sector and 25% from National Resources and falls under the Special Objective "Risks and Crises" and the National Objective "Prevention and Combating" of the Internal Security Fund 2014-2020.

The above action contributed to maintaining a high level of internal security in Greece and the European Union, as well as to the effective prevention in the face of serious and organized crime by achieving the following:

- Creating the Operations Centre which for real time information management, facilitating the response to cooperation requests and sharing information, supporting ongoing investigations and the punctual identification of incidents.
- Creating an Information Platform which will connect HPiD with the regional information structures,
- Training the HPiD's staff to ensure the maximum utilization of the software applications.



"Establishment of the National Passenger Information Unit (PIU) for the development of the PNR (Passenger Name Record) System"

By the Hellenic Police Intelligence Directorate of the Hellenic Police Headquarters has been completed the implementation of the action entitled "supply of necessary logistical - electronic equipment, software and applications for the future operation of the national Passenger Information Unit, provided for in article 4 of Directive (EU) 2016/681 of the European Parliament and the Council regarding the use of the data contained in the Passenger Name Records (PNR) for the prevention, detection, investigation and prosecution of terrorist and serious crimes of April 27 (EEL 119 of 4/5/2016 p.132-149)".

This action was co-financed by 75% from the European Internal Security Fund / Police Cooperation Sector and by 25% from National Resources.
